To celebrate the re-issue of his groundbreaking study, *Remembrance Of Patients Past* (University of Toronto Press), scholar and activist **Geoffrey Reaume** will conduct a walking tour of the **Centre for Addiction and Mental Health** (CAMH) grounds. He will then guide the group to the Gladstone Hotel, where he will be interviewed by **Ruth Ruth Stackhouse** of **Friendly Spike Theatre Band**. There will be a silent auction of bricks painted by local artists.
